Our Staff

Orchard Court has an experienced manager who leads a qualified and experienced care team who are on duty 24 hours a day, seven days a week. We continually invest in training our staff to help them develop and gain NVQ qualifications in care. This helps us to continue to improve the care provided to all residents.

We are very proud of the long length of service of many of our staff, which helps us to provide a stable and caring environment for our residents. We also have an innovative activities co-ordinator who organises a wide range of social activities to encourage residents to enjoy their stay to the full.

Features of Orchard Court

- Attractive and personal bedrooms and bungalows
 - 40 beds in total, mainly in single rooms but with two twin room for residents who prefer companionship
 - The majority of rooms have en-suite facilities
 - Thirteen bungalows with their own sitting room, kitchen, bedroom and bathroom, for residents who like a little more privacy and independence.
 - 24 hour call facility in all rooms
 - Television point in all bedrooms
 - All furniture and furnishings are provided, but we encourage residents to bring anything they would like with them to help them feel at home
 - Most rooms are on the ground floor
- Two spacious, comfortable residents' sitting rooms and a further dining area
- Pleasant terrace area and raised garden to front
- Landscaped patio area to rear
- Several assisted bathrooms and toilets
- Ample car parking




Services offered

Maintaining high standards


