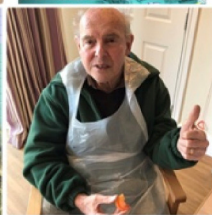
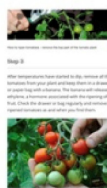
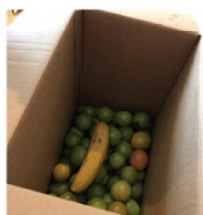
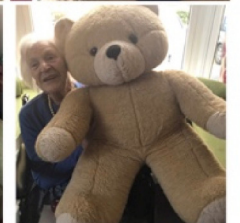
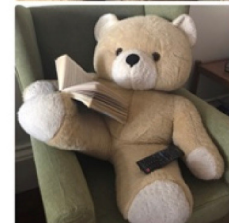
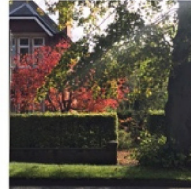
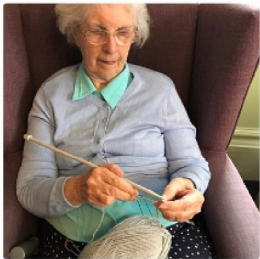
To our Orchard Team

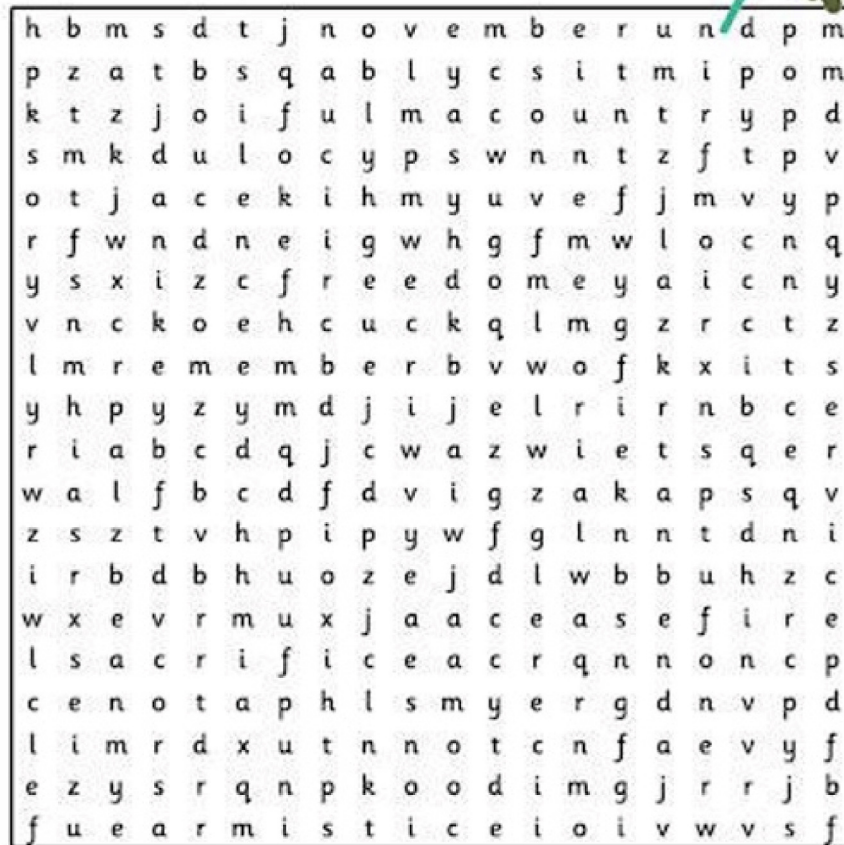
